Ingleton and Summerhouse Village Halls are closed, the school's closed and church services have been suspended at St. John's. The 2020 Village Fayre has been cancelled due to the uncertainty of knowing when normal life will return to normal. Thank you to those who have already spent a great deal of time and effort in organising it.

Despite being a small community it's surprising how many events happen, and many of these are organised and enjoyed by the 'self isolating' group who will now feel even more isolated.

The good news is that The Black Horse is open and action is being taken to organise help for those who need assistance. There are suppliers continuing to offer free home deliveries locally, including Simon's Butchers in Staindrop and take out meals from the Black Horse (see separate information) and Coghlan's at Barningham 07494 582444 or email sales@coghlanscatering.co.uk

The Parish Council has decided to cancel its meetings. This of course does not mean that people should not continue to contact the Clerk with any queries or concerns as any communications will be forwarded to the most relevant person for a response. A Letter from the Vicar

The last few weeks have been an extraordinary time as the Coronavirus pandemic has gradually reached around the world and driven more and more countries and communities into some kind of isolation.

In the last few days the fluid state of things has seen daily updates from the Government, and for clergy similar updates from the Archbishops and Bishops.

Last night the information came that all schools would close from Friday 20th March with no set date for their re-opening. Some fear this could well be at the start of the new academic year in September.

Also this week saw the unprecedented move by the Archbishops to formally suspend all public worship in Anglican churches and chapels. Many other faith groups have also issued similar suspensions to try and protect the public.

In these very trying times, we are all being asked to live in some kind of isolation. Not mixing or socialising with friends seems the last thing we would ever want to suggest, and yet here we are looking at not celebrating Mothering Sunday / Mother's Day or Easter and trying to work out how to keep in touch. Here the advent of mobile phone and smart phones have been a great help, and some churches and cathedrals will live stream services to a virtual congregation. Currently this is not something I am able to do.

Although public worship has been suspended, some things will continue in the background as they always have. Clergy and others will still be praying for their communities; Christenings, Weddings and Funerals can currently take place albeit in a very curtailed way. Hopefully this will not be curtailed further.

As the situation develops I will try to keep people up to date through the Staindrop Church's website, and through telephone calls so that information can be spread.

In the meantime my good wishes to you all, and as the window cleaner said in passing yesterday – keep well.
