



## Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations and Fayre in Ingleton June 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> 2022

Preparations are well under way for the village to celebrate the momentous occasion of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee this year. We decided to combine the celebrations with the village Fayre this year, which has sadly been cancelled for two consecutive years.

Here is a list of events which are planned - on the back of this letter, there is a list of things for which we still need volunteers or things you can get involved with.

**Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> June** - we are starting our village celebrations with a family picnic. Bring along seats, picnic rugs, food, drinks etc to the playing field from around 12 o'clock and set up your family picnic so we can all get together to toast the Queen. We'll sing The National Anthem at 1 o'clock, wave flags and raise a toast to celebrate her 70 years on the throne!

**Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> June 1pm to 4pm** - the theme of the Fayre is the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. The Pavilion, stalls and (perhaps) stallholders will be decorated in red, white and blue as well as having a children's fancy dress competition with a royal theme. There will be the usual stalls - tombola, bric a brac, garden stall, a good variety of craft stalls, a raffle with great prizes etc. There will also be a classic car show, Middleton Silver band will entertain us throughout the afternoon, inflatables, face painting, a fun dog show, a judo demonstration, children's races with prizes, coconut shy and a dog agility course to try out. Delicious afternoon teas will be served in the village hall as well as a display of photographs and films of Ingleton from days gone by. Bacon sandwiches will be served in the Pavilion along with an exhibition of art and handwriting by pupils from Ingleton school.

In St John's Church you can look at the floral displays made by families, individuals and groups from Ingleton and the surrounding area as well as a photography competition to view.

### **Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June**

St John's Church will again be open to view the floral displays and photography competition. A service of celebration and thanksgiving for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee has been arranged at 2pm - everyone is welcome.

Open Gardens of Ingleton 1pm to 4pm - a chance to have an informal look around some of the gardens in the village, there will be a small charge for a map to view the gardens taking part. Refreshments will be served in one or more of the gardens.
